THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT YR A

14th December 2025

Come, Lord, and save us.

Rejoice in the Lord always, and again I say rejoice!

There will be one obvious difference this weekend at Mass. Not with our music, or indeed with our liturgy. No, indeed- it will be me, resplendent in pink- or "rose" as the Ordo says. Today is Gaudete Sunday- "Rejoice" Sunday. Advent used to be seen as a very penitential season, like Lent. We can see vestiges of this in the tradition of people going to Reconciliation before Christmas. It is still a brilliant way of preparing for the festive season, but now we see Advent as a time with its own character. Another vestige is this day, originally, like Laetare Sunday (Be Happy Sunday) in Lent, a time of relaxation of our penitential discipline. This is symbolized by the colour: anyone who has washed purple clothes in a long 60° wash will know that it will fade to pink. It's a lighter day of Advent!

However, given that Advent is not now the same as Lent, what does this mean? Our readings point us in the right direction. Our first reading and Gospel suggest, as we have seen through Advent, the joys, and indeed miracles, which will accompany the arrival of the Messiah, or, more accurately, the risen Lord Jesus. But how, then, is today different from any other day in Advent? I think the key is in our second reading. It tells us to "be patient". Good advice for this season of waiting, but the Greek is a little different: it exhorts us to "be big in spirit"- be big-hearted. We can rejoice today that our Saviour died and rose again to save us- let's also be big-hearted, sharing God's love with everyone whom we meet.
